Thank you for considering commissioning a Caricature. They are a great gift to give, and a great gift to get. I've been doing caricatures since I discovered them as a child. Since then I have been making my living creating caricatures now for over 18 years, having drawn thousands of faces.



- what we need from you-

The information you give me will lay the foundations of your Caricature. The more thought and consideration you put into it, the more uniquely special it will be for the recipient.

PHOTOS/IMAGES

Dig out the photo albums (or these days the digital photo albums). The more recent pictures you can provide us with the better the caricature.

- We need some clear face shots, about half a dozen is usually good (but the more the merrier)
- A body can be caricaturized as well as a face, include some full body photos as well
- Let us know if things have changed. For example we can sketch hair shorter and make belies bigger if the photos don't show it
- If there's photos of their car, favourite footy jumper, pet anything you'd like to be included in the caricature give us those as well.
- Images gathered from the internet are most welcome (these can help if you haven't got photos of particular things eg. a specific car model, a footy logo, etc).
- Facebook is often a good way to gather photos and information

Remember, we've only got the photos to go by, the more we can see the better the likeness. Of course all actual photos will be returned with the completed caricature. Digital photos are accepted, please supply as large a file as possible.

INFORMATION

What do you want in it? The more details you put into the caricature the better it can be.

- Do you want the picture to have a theme, say at the beach?
- What are they wearing?
- What'd their personality? Loud and obnoxious?
 Shy and quirky?
- Have they got a particular pose? (eg. hand in pocket? arms crossed? wide stance?)
- Have they got a favourite drink?
- What do they do for a living?
- What do they do in their spare time?
- Where are they from?
- Travels?
- What's important to them?
- Any amusing or memorable incidents you can embarrass them with?

Get the idea? Every little thing makes the picture more personal. The more thought you put into it, the more they'll get out of it

SIZES

Our standard sizes of A4, A3 and A2 are approximate and may vary slightly depending on the design and layout of the caricature. If you're after a particular size (maybe to fit a standard store-bought frame) just let us know and we'll do it to suit.

BASIC/STANDARD/COMPLEX

What's in the caricature. If you want heaps it will be complex, if you just want the subject and not much else, that's basic. Somewhere in between- standard.

TIMING

Generally about a month. But saying that, if you give us longer we'll take longer, or you need something a bit quicker we'll do everything we can to get it to you on time.

FRAMING

Framing is optional. We can often frame your caricature for less than what you will probably pay at a commercial picture framer. We use only jarrah timber with a satin or oil finish. Every caricature comes bordered with a quality Crescent mattboard. (This is the colour border surrounding most framed pictures). If you'd like a double matt or a particular colour just let us know.

SUBMITTING YOUR CONTENT

If you'd like to commission a caricature phone or send me an email of what you'd like so I can schedule it in. I will then give you an approximate deadline of when I'll be needing you to submit your photos and information. You can post these to me or digital photos and information can be emailed to fatarts@fatarts.com.au. (Please send digital photos as large as possible.)

COLLECTION/DELIVERY

All Caricatures can be collected from Fat Arts in Bridgetown. Unframed caricatures can be posted within Australia for \$15 or overseas. Framed caricatures can be couriered at your expense (we use couriers only as a very last resort and at your own risk). Often we travel to Perth and can bring your caricature and arrange collection or delivery.

PAYMENT

Unless otherwise arranged, we require payment upon collection or delivery of the caricature. The following methods are accepted: cash, direct deposit (EFT), Paypal, Credit Card and direct deposit (EFT). Our EFT details are: account name- Fat arts, bsb 736121, account numbe 517980.
